## CCBC FAMILY LITERACY ESOL PROGRAM SPRING 2024

Interested in gaining English language skills for life, work and active involvement in your child's education? We're excited to introduce you to the Family Literacy English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) Program at the Community College of Baltimore County (CCBC)! This program is designed for parents whose first language is not English.

### ELIGIBILITY

You must have a child aged 0-16 living in your home who is either attending a Baltimore County Public School or the Judy Center of Baltimore County. You also must be at least 18 years old and officially withdrawn from high school. F-1 or J-1 visa holders are not eligible.

### COST

No cost for class. Grant-funded.\*

However, you will need to purchase a student textbook and workbook, available at any CCBC campus bookstore.
