CHANGE IN SCHOOL HOURS/BELL TIMES

The school day for the 2021-2022 school year has been extended by fifteen (15) minutes. Our updated school hours/bell times are:

8:20 AM- 1st bell rings and doors open to students. (Please do not drop off students early. There will be no supervision before 8:20 AM.)

8:35 AM- Late bell rings and doors are closed. Students arriving after 8:35 AM must be walked into the building by an adult to receive a late slip.

3:20 PM- Dismissal of students. Walkers and car riders are picked up from their exterior classroom door. All students must be picked up at 3:20 PM, if not a bus rider. School administration may contact authorities for any students not picked up on time.
